10 Warning Signs of Cancer in Dogs*

1. Recent lump or bump that persists or grows in size
2. Sores or wounds that do not heal
3. Weight loss with or without change in food intake
4. Change in appetite or water consumption
5. Bleeding or discharge from any body opening
6. Offensive odors
7. Difficulty eating, chewing, grasping or swallowing food
8. Reluctance to exercise or loss of stamina
9. Persistent lameness
10. Difficulty breathing, urinating or defecating

Cancer is a serious threat to all dogs. One in four dogs will develop cancer in their lifetime and countless families will experience devastating effects of this deadly disease.



All dogs face a high cancer risk, but it increases for some of the most popular breeds.
