What data do we collect?

LEEP Calendar collects the following data from professional members and champion members related to their subscriptions.

- Personal identification information (Name, email address, phone number, etc.)
- Company identification information (Name, email address, phone number, etc.)
- Event-specific information from registered champions and publicly available sources.

How do we collect your data?

You directly provide LEEP Calendar with most of the data we collect. We collect data and process data when you:

- Register online or place an order for any of our products or services.
- Voluntarily complete a customer survey or provide feedback on any of our message boards or via email.
- Research of publicly available sources related to indexed events.
- Use or view our website via your browser's cookies.

LEEP Calendar may also receive your data indirectly from the following sources:

- Third-party platforms you've opted into.

How will we use your data?

LEEP Calendar collects your data so that we can:

- Process your subscription and manage your account.
- Email you with special offers on other products and services we think you might like.
- Verify the authenticity of an event and identify the champions behind them.

If you agree, LEEP Calendar will share your data with our partner companies so that they may offer you their products and services.

- Advertising is provided through Google, and commerce functions through Stripe.

When LEEP Calendar's payment processor resolves your order, it may send your data and use the resulting information from credit reference agencies to prevent fraudulent purchases.

How do we store your data?

LEEP Calendar securely stores your non-financial subscription data through our secured hosting server with GoDaddy Operating Company, LLC in Tempe, Arizona, United States. All financial data is stored with Stripe, Inc. in San Francisco, California, United States.

LEEP Calendar will keep your subscription information for a period of your subscription and up to 60 days once canceled. Once this time period has expired, we will delete your data. Once deleted, you will need to set up a new account at the current subscription rate.

Exception: All event-related data, images, videos, and downloadable attachments remain in our database as part of the historical record and will not be deleted upon canceling a champion subscription.

Marketing

LEEP Calendar would like to send you information about our products and services of that we think you might like, as well as those of our partner companies.

- Currently, we do not partner with other companies.

If you have agreed to receive marketing, you may always opt-out at a later date.

You have the right at any time to stop LEEP Calendar from contacting you for marketing purposes or giving your data to future partners.

If you no longer wish to be contacted for marketing purposes, please adjust the settings in your subscriber console. Non-subscribers do not receive marketing from LEEP.

What are your data protection rights?

LEEP Calendar would like to make sure you are fully aware of all of your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:

The right to access – You have the right to request LEEP Calendar for copies of your personal data. We may charge you a small fee for this service.

The right to rectification – You have the right to request that LEEP Calendar correct any personal information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request LEEP Calendar to complete the information you believe is incomplete.

The right to erasure – You have the right to request that LEEP Calendar erase your personal data under certain conditions.

The right to restrict processing – You have the right to request that LEEP Calendar restrict the processing of your personal data under certain conditions.

The right to object to processing – You have the right to object to LEEP Calendar processing of your personal data under certain conditions.

The right to data portability – You have the right to request that LEEP Calendar transfer your personal data to another organization or directly to you under certain conditions.

Cookies

Cookies are text files placed on your computer to collect standard Internet log information and visitor behavior information. When you visit our websites, we may collect information

from you automatically through cookies or similar technology. For further information, visit allaboutcookies.org.

How do we use cookies?

LEEP Calendar uses cookies in a range of ways to improve your experience on our website, including:

- Keeping you signed in
- Understanding how you use our website

What types of cookies do we use?

There are a number of different types of cookies. However, our website uses:

- **Functionality** – LEEP Calendar uses these cookies so that we recognize you on our website and remember your previously selected preferences. These could include what language you prefer and the location you are in. A mix of first-party and third-party cookies are used.
- **Advertising** – LEEP Calendar uses these cookies to collect information about your visit to our website, the content you viewed, the links you followed and information about your browser, device, and your IP address. LEEP Calendars sometimes shares some limited aspects of this data with third parties for advertising purposes. We may also share online data collected through cookies with our advertising partners. This means that when you visit another website, you may be shown advertising based on your browsing patterns on our website.
- **Analytics** — LEEP Calendar uses Google Analytics for marketing, research and functionality.

How to manage cookies

You can set your browser not to accept cookies, and the above website tells you how to remove cookies from your browser. However, in a few cases, some of our website features may not function as a result.
